ICE CLEAT WINTER TIPS

BEFORE THE SEASON STARTS – INSPECT, ORDER AND PLAN BEFORE WINTER HITS



If using Ice cleats from last season, visually inspect for any cracked/cut rubber, frayed materials, worn or missing spikes, and replace if necessary



Visually inspect Ice cleats daily to ensure optimal performance.
When in doubt, talk with your Safety Director about ordering a new pair



Put ice cleats on before you go outside, remove ice cleats or rotate spikes up (Mid-Sole) when going indoors to prevent damage to flooring



When storing ice cleats, keep them away from extreme temperatures, as it can damage the product



Anticipate slippery conditions & watch out for black ice, freeze/thaw cycles create very slippery conditions



Always remember to use caution when there is snow and ice
